1. OUR SCHOOL

2. SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMME

3. SCHEDULE

4. ELIGIBILITY

You must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Hold a non-Japanese passport, and be born between April 2nd 2006 and December 31st, 2009.
- 2) Hold a Japanese passport, and be born between April 2nd 2006 and December 31st, 2009. Applicants should have spent more than five years of schooling abroad as a general rule.

Note: All applicants must have completed the equivalent of 9 years of schooling (by August 2023.)

5. FEES

Total fees for the summer school program are 60,000yen. This includes all basic expenses such as transportation, and accommodation for the duration of the program.*



6. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Submit online application form
- · Applicants receive email notification of received application (within 10 days)
- · Applicants register self-introduction video and submit personal information
- Applicants receive notification of acceptance
- Applicants receive final confirmation (via email in order of application)
- Participants submit payment through bank transfer
- · Participants will be notified of any additional payments

1st Round: February 1st 2022 - May 1st 2022. Priority will be given to students born between April 2nd, 2006 and **December 31st, 2008.**

2nd Round: May 2nd 2022 - June 1st 2022. Priority will be given to students born April 2nd, 2006 and December 31st, 2009.
